About the Journal

The Chinese Historical Review (CHR) is a fully refereed academic journal with issues appearing in March and November each year. Originally created in 1987 by the Chinese Historians in the United States, Inc. (CHUS), the journal was published under the name *Chinese Historians* until 2000 (Volumes 1-10). Under the new title, the journal retains its intellectual rigor, imagination and quality as an international journal of history and continues to provide a scholarly platform for historical research on China and Chinese history related issues and a transnational forum for scholarly exchanges on the study of history.

Call for Papers

The Chinese Historical Review publishes original research on all periods of Chinese history, history of China's relations with the other nations and societies of the world, historical experiences of the overseas Chinese. It also publishes comparative studies of history and China-related world history topics. In addition, the journal publishes research notes on historiography, historical theories and methods, and historical materials, especially those concerning the study of Chinese history. The journal's forum presents discussion of the state of the field with historians in different countries. The journal's book review section introduces recent historical scholarship published in Chinese generally unavailable to the English speaking world.

CHR invites scholars in the fields of Chinese history and China-related studies to submit manuscripts of original research in the areas as above mentioned. CHR also welcomes research notes, review articles, and comprehensive book reviews. Article manuscripts will be reviewed anonymously by external referees.

Article manuscripts should not exceed 10,000 words. Research notes should not exceed 3,500 words. Book reviews are normally between 1,200 and 1,500 words. All texts, including footnotes, quotations and list of cited works, should be double spaced. Authors of articles should attach an abstract of 250 words and a short biographic note of about 100 words. All submissions should be sent in text (three copies) and electronic (Word 2000 or higher) format.
